The Scholarship Fund of the Western Union Baptist District Association was established to aide aspiring African American youth who express a desire and demonstrate preparation for attendance at an accredited University, College, or Trade School. The Scholarship was renamed Deacon James P. Humphrey at the 135th Annual Session of the WUBDA.

General Requirements For Each Applicant:

Applications **must** be complete, including, but not limited to each general requirement in order to be considered.

Applicant <u>must</u> be an established member of his/her church (by letter, baptism, or Christian experience and having the right-hand of fellowship) as verified by his/her Pastor and Church Clerk.

Church <u>must</u> have registered with the WUBDA for the previous calendar year - **2024**. (Churches have up to the **May 2025** Quarterly Session to register.

Applicant <u>must</u> be a <u>current high school senior</u> and show proof, passing <u>all</u> PARTS Ohio Graduation Test (OGT) and submit official documentation from his/her high school when applicable. Please provide proof if not indicated on transcript.

Applicant <u>must</u> submit an Official High School Transcript of academic accomplishments and have a <u>minimum</u> cumulative **2.5 GPA.** (Official Transcript must be sent directly from his/her high school and include SAT and/or ACT scores. *NOTE: If scores are not printed on transcript, applicant must provide documentation from the SAT/ACT website providing scores.

Applicant <u>must</u> answer each of the questions completely under "Other Data" (page 7)

Applicant <u>must</u> attach three written letters <u>on letterhead</u> of personal references, one of which <u>must</u> be from his/her Pastor, high school educator and whomever. **Note:** Each letter must be signed by the writer, contain contact information on letterhead.

Applicant must submit official documentation that you will be attending a specific college:

▶ Letter of acceptance, financial aid awarded payment of tuition, dorm assignment, and or class schedule.

Applicant <u>must</u> attach a small non-returnable picture or one that is comparable. **Digital pictures** are acceptable if submitted on a flash/jump drive, CD or **e-mailed to jomohu@aol.com**. (NOTE: Recipient's picture may be used in our publications and/or Website.) **Applicant must submit a profile document**.

Applicant <u>must</u> submit with the application and <u>e-mail the essay prior to mailing</u> to the designated committee person, an original essay, consisting of a <u>minimum</u> of **600 words**. The topic must be as described on **page 8**. Recipients are expected to personally attend the WUBDA Youth Night ~ <u>Monday</u>, <u>July 28</u>, <u>2025</u>. Specific information will be provided when available.

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REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

(Applicants must complete all the requirements to meet eligibility requirements.)

Applicant must be a **high school senior** graduating before **July 2025**.

The Scholarship Applicant

- A. Must be a prospective high school graduate in the year of application. Currently be enrolled in high school with satisfactory progression toward graduation in the year the scholarship is awarded.
- B. Must use funds for undergraduate studies.
- C. Must have a grade point average (GPA) of at least **2.5.**
- D. Must be a full-time student and/or registered as a full-time student. Registration documentation must be provided.
- E. Submit three (3) letters of recommendation, on original letterhead and signed. One must be from the applicant's Pastor, one from, high school educator and whomever. Note: Each letter must be signed by the writer, contain contact information on letterhead
- F. Must have attended Christian Education classes (Sunday School and/or Bible Study in the local church.
- G. Must participate in the overall life of the church.

Procedures/Policy

- A. The committee will evaluate each associational applicant based on a set of criteria adopted by the committee.
- B. Other than grade point average, the information reported on the application is classified as being true. Designated points are given for Educational Background, Church Participation, Economic Need, Community Participation, and Neatly Submitted Applications.
- C. The three (3) highest scoring applicants will be selected. Only ONE finalist per church.
- D. A monetary scholarship will be awarded to the three finalists. The names of the scholarship recipients will be withheld from the public until the beginning of WUBDA Annual 2025 Session.
- E. Scholarships will be awarded in one lump sum disbursement.
- F. Letters of recommendation must be included with the scholarship application. Please, **only one application per envelope.**
- G. Faxes will not be accepted.
